This database will allow customers to view, print, and download certificates of testing and certificates of conformance for the products they purchase from Halo. The database will be customer specific, meaning customers must log in to browse or search for the information they need. This feature will help Halo's customers get certifications they need when they need them, 24/7.

Another special feature included on the site will be equipment videos displaying Halo's equipment performing the tasks they are designed to do. This service will allow Halo's customers to get a detailed look at how their products are made. Break testing on Halo's 3,000,000 lb. load test bed will also deliver exciting videos of large mooring lines and slings releasing all their energy in an explosion that must be seen to believe.

Once Halo's Fourchon facility is operational halosupply.net will be updated with a live webcam focused on the 3,000,000 lb. load test bed. This feature will allow customers to see the activity near the test bed in addition to a load graph indicating the pulling force exerted at any given moment.
